ज़िंदगी की इमारत -तू ज़िंदगी जी कर तो देख

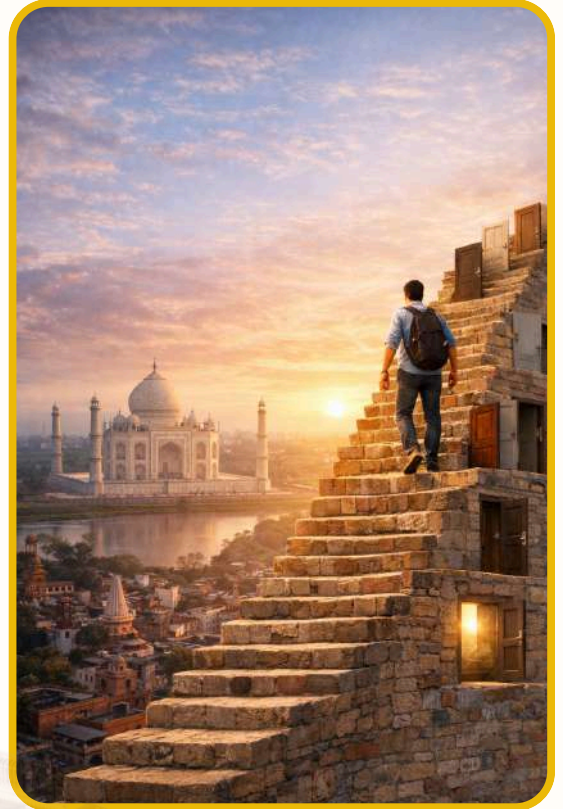
देख कैसी सीना तान कर सीधी खड़ी है ये इमारत।

और मृत्यु में शायद उसी में समा जाती हैं।

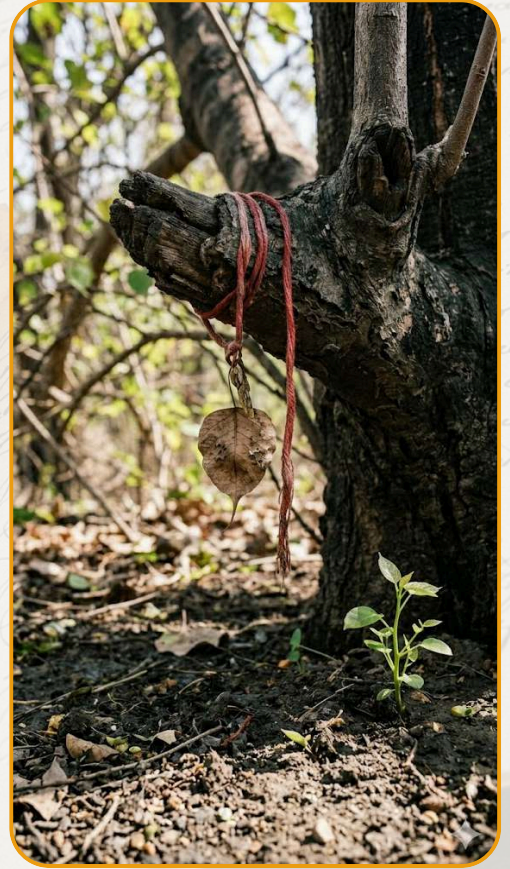
मैं वहीं खड़ी हूँ—
